- Read to someone or bring a child to Storytime this summer



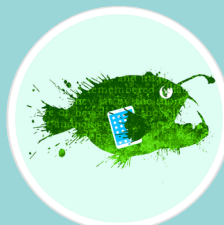
Everything is Tawesome
