

This is the perfect time to bring back those late items or renew your card!







GEER Grant Update

Earlier this year, we received a grant provided by the Georgia Public Library Service with federal pandemic funding from the State of Georgia Governor's Office. We were able to add items to our collection, like Chromebooks and Launchpads, to help improve our community's access to technology,
